The information detailed below should be read in conjunction with our standard Market Regulations. Please note that from 16 March until 30 April 2024 the Market will undergo a review of all aspects of its operations. During this period, the information below is subject to change and all regular stallholders will be advised by email. Note also that a new booking and payment system will come into operation during this period.

If you attend as Casual and do NOT have your own insurance cover, you will be charged an additional \$20.00 on your stall fee and have cover under the Market's Public & Product Liability Insurance Cover.

Stall Sizes

What you CAN sell at the Markets?

At the Market, we welcome arts, crafts, handmade items, clothing, accessories, jewellery, bric-a-brac, art, photography, furniture, salvaged items, food, records, CDs, DVDs, vintage clothing and re-claimed or re-purposed pieces... the list goes on.

What you CANNOT Sell at the Market?

Detailed below are items we are **NOT** permitted to sell at the Markets:

Health/Cosmetics/Medicines/Alcohol/ Amusements, Electrical Goods/Tools, Massage/Therapy, Hazardous and Dangerous Goods, Ammunition, Automobile Parts, Bicycles, Child Restraint Devices, Christmas Tree lights, Firearms, Children's Furniture, Sporting goods or athletic equipment, Protective equipment, Ride on Toys ie Skateboards, roller skates roller blades, water amusement equipment, Projectile toys, E cigarettes,

Weather & Refund Policy

The Market is conducted in the open air and will operate in varying weather conditions including wet and windy weather. It is the responsibility of the Stallholder to bring their own covers and weights to hold down equipment and protect their stall and products in adverse weather conditions. The Market will NOT be cancelled in the event of wet weather, but we may cancel in extreme weather conditions. The Market is not cancelled ahead of time. Stallholders are solely responsible to decide as to whether they will trade in bad weather conditions. Pease note that no refunds are issued.

Rubbish & Waste

All rubbish, waste and packaging must be taken away with the stallholder. Bins provided do NOT cater for stallholder rubbish. The stall site must be left in the condition it was found.

Market Stall Insurance Requirements

Regular and Regular Casual Stallholders MUST have their own cover.

If you are a 'Regular Stallholder' or a 'Regular Casual Stallholder' as described below, you MUST have in place a public and product liability policy with a minimum of \$10,000,000 cover for each insurable event in the Stallholder's name with the Manager's interest noted on the policy.

A copy of the Insurance Certificate of Currency must be supplied to the Manager before you may trade at the Market. It is the responsibility of the stallholder to ensure that the insurance is renewed and remains current for the term that the stallholder undertakes trading activity at the Market.

Casual Stallholders

If you do NOT have stallholder insurance cover, you may attend the Market and the Market Public and Product Liability Insurance cover will extend its cover to you, subject to this policy's various exclusions. Your stall fee will be increased by \$20.00 if you do not have your own cover.

What is a Casual Stallholder?

A Casual Stallholder must book and pay for a stall prior to attending the Market. You will be allocated a spot in the Market after you have pre-paid your stall fee online.

What is a Regular Casual Stallholder?

A Stallholder is classified as a Regular Casual Stallholder after you have attended the Market 6 times in the current calendar year. After 6 attendances, you will be classified as a Regular Casual and MUST obtain your own stallholder public and products liability insurance.

What does it mean to be a Regular Stallholder?

If you are a Regular Stallholder, you do not need to book each week. A fixed stall space is held for you unless you cancel beforehand. Your Regular Stall will be held for you until 9.00 am on Market Day. After this time, the spot may be given away to Casuals or Standbys.

A Regular Stallholder has the advantage of a fixed regular position, so customers can get to know where to find you and you can then build your repeat customer base. Regular Spots are generally the best locations in the Market and most of these spots allow stallholder to drive their vehicles up to their stalls to unload.

Please note that paying a Stall Fee or becoming a Regular Stallholder does create any form of legal or equitable tenancy or imply any future legal right/s or license.

If you wish to become a Regular Stallholder, please speak to the Manager. We will review your stall and consider whether it may be included in the mix of stalls and stallholders who are already Regulars.

Stall Cancellation Policy

If you cancel by **Monday 5.00 pm prior to Market Day,** you will NOT be charged for that coming weekend. Please note that you MUST cancel in writing by sending an email to office@blueskymarkets.com.au
